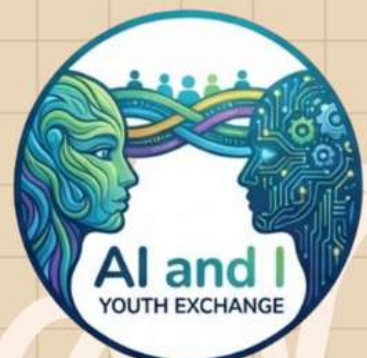

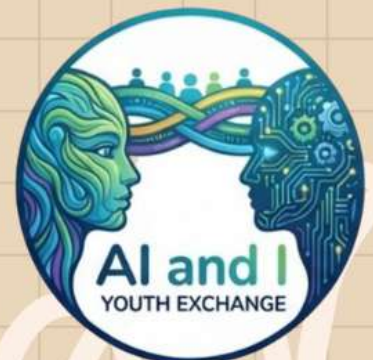

I learned more about AI, but also about communication, teamwork and being open to new experiences. I learned how to work with new people, share ideas and see things from different perspectives.

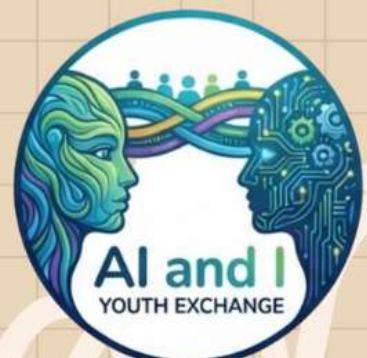

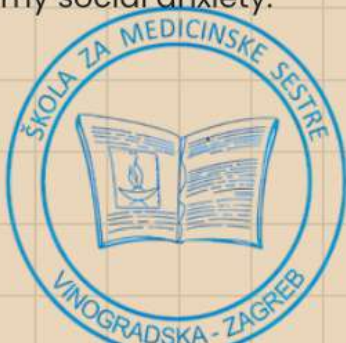


WHAT PEOPLE SAY!
